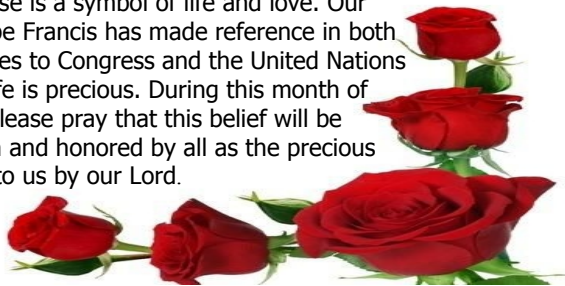
Youth Confirmation is a two-year process. Students need

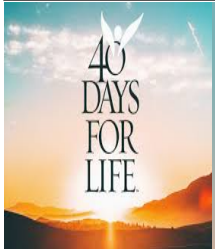


### October is Respect Life Month
