G.P.'s Music Corner

April 27, 2025

Second Sunday of Easter

Carey Landry's "***All is Well with My Soul***" is based on "***It is Well with My Soul***" by Horatio Spafford. Spafford composed the hymn while crossing the Atlantic Ocean to meet his wife in England who had traveled ahead of him. During her journey, the boat she was on collided with a sea vessel and their four daughters perished along with hundreds of other passengers. This tragedy, compounded by his family's massive financial losses due to the Great Chicago Fire of 1871 would have been enough reason for him to lose hope. Yet, he must have been so moved by the reassuring love of God that he was compelled to write a hopeful hymn in the face of the pain they were facing. I imagine this process helped him in his grief and in the rebuilding of his life with his wife Anna. Indeed, his song, which celebrated its 150th birthday in 2023 must have become such a classic precisely because it has become a channel through which God's reassuring love pours over those that sing and hear it. May it be a prayer for those of us this Sunday who are struggling. May God's reassuring love still the restless waters of our soul and may his divine mercy wash over those that thirst for it.
