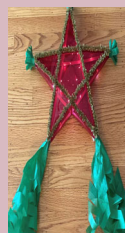

The Ascension of the Lord

It seems ironic to reflect on death on a day that refers to "ascension." But as Christians, we know how the two are linked. In the ascension, not only do we commemorate the end of Christ's earthly ministry, we are also reminded that his intercession for us persists. He advocates for the Church and prepares a place for believers. Which brings me to the death part of the reflection. I've been a church musician all my life (as a kid who volunteered and as a professional musician) and have played for hundreds of funerals.
